SOUTH MAIN ARTSPACE LOFTS PROJECT RECIEVES EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION OF AMERICA GRANT

Memphis Project Closing in on Fundraising Goal

MEMPHIS, **TN – Artspace Projects**, **Inc**. is pleased to announce that it has received a \$250,000 gift from **The Educational Foundation of America** (EFA), a New York-based philanthropic organization, toward the development of its South Main Artspace Lofts project downtown Memphis.

South Main Artspace Lofts, located at 138 St. Paul Avenue in the South Main Arts District, will be a 58-unit development of affordable live/work space for artists that includes both adaptive reuse of an existing warehouse and new construction. The project is estimated to cost approximately \$15 million, of which all but the last \$400,000 has been secured. The Hyde Family Foundations, the Assisi Foundation of Memphis, the Ford Foundation, the City of Memphis, and the Downtown Memphis Commission are all contributors to the project, which also relies upon various tax credit packages from the State of Tennessee.

"We are so grateful that The Educational Foundation of America understands the critical role artists play in the healthy and sustainable development of communities like Memphis," said Heidi Zimmer, Senior VP of Property Development for Artspace. "Their generosity accelerates the momentum behind South Main Artspace Lofts and brings us significantly closer to breaking ground on this remarkable project."

EFA Executive Director Melissa Beck said, "The Educational Foundation of America is pleased to support Artspace as they build a bright future for artists and the creative economy of South Main itself and Memphis as a whole."
